

Frequently Asked Questions

How does my organization schedule a call?

Contact DSAIA at director@dsaia.org or by phone at 701.425.7129 to schedule your next conference call. An e-mail with call-in information will be sent as a confirmation of your scheduled conference call.

How much advance notice is required to schedule a call?

A minimum of 48 hours prior notice is requested. Special circumstances may dictate a shorter time frame for scheduling. Exceptions to the policy may be made at the discretion of the Executive Director.

Is this service free to our organization?

Yes! There is no fee associated with the GoToMeeting service offered through DSAIA. Your organization will not be billed for any calls whatsoever.

Is there any cost involved to the call participants?

Participants using lines with free long distance will incur no charges. Call-in numbers are long distance and participants should be aware of the possibility of charges to their phone plan. Either land lines or cell phones may be used. Participants need not choose a phone line in advance.

FREE CONFERENCE CALL SERVICE

DSAIA's latest VIP Program offering is unlimited conference call capability for your organization. Conference call capability can give your organization the opportunity to have meetings without participants leaving home or office. If it is distance, tight schedules or short notice keeping your meetings from happening, conference calls may be the solution.

The GoToMeeting VIP Program is available only to DSAIA members and includes unlimited conference calls. *The conference call is free to your organization. Dialing in is a long-distance call. As long as the participants dialing in have free long distance, the entire conference call is free of charge.* There is no time limit on the length of the call or limit on the number of participants. Calls can be made from either land lines or cell phones.

We ask that member organizations schedule calls through the DSAIA Executive Director 48 hours in advance by e-mail or phone. Exceptions to the 48 hour advance notice policy can be made at the Executive Director's discretion.

Meeting invitations will be sent directly to your organization through e-mail with complete dial-in instructions. These invitations can be forwarded to your meeting participants.
